

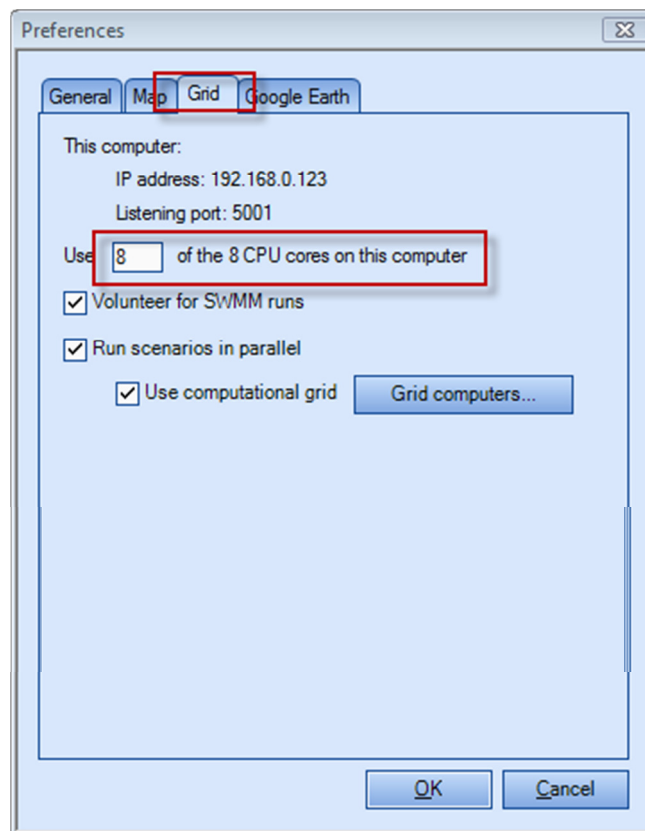


H12 – How to run multiple scenarios

This how-to page reviews how to run multiple scenarios by leveraging multiple cores available on your computer or office network.

How to run multiple scenarios

1. Create the scenarios using the **Scenario**  manager.
2. Once your scenarios have been set up click on the **Scenario** button and check to see all of the scenarios that are listed are the ones you wish to run.
3. In the **Map** panel click on the **Menu**  button and select **Preferences**.
4. In the **Preferences** window click on the **Grid** tab.




5. Volunteer the maximum number of CPUs you have available. In the case of the screen shot above there are 8 CPUs available.
6. Click **Ok**.

Note: you are also able to use the cores from other computers in the network by clicking on the **Grid computers...** button

7. In project panel click on the arrow beside the **Run** button



8. Click on the scenarios you wish to run and click on the  button.
